I have checked with Mr Iskander and his response is that " as far as we know there was no Bendahara on the island at the time of Raffles' arrival. There is no documentary evidence to indicate that the Riau Bendahara was based in Singapore. The Pahang Bendahara did visit Singapore on his way back home to Pahang." (Source : Hikayat Pahang). I need to check further on the claim that Rumah Bendahara was built for Tengku Mahmud, the younger son of Sultan Ali, whom later changed the name Rumah Bendahara to Gedung Kuning.
